

MODERN ART QUILTERS Sew-A-Long

SHWESHWE JAM

Shweshwe is a most delicious African printed fabric, and I have a box full. As with all these fabrics, it's hard to cut them the first time, so please regard this pattern as an excuse to use some of your over-the-top why-did-I-buy-this...

Blocks finish at 8-1/2 inches (8 inches when sewn together)

For one block you need to cut

For the crust:- 2 pieces 4-1/2 by 2-1/2 inches
2 pieces 8-1/2 by 2-1/2 inches

For the jam filling - one piece 4-1/2 inches square



Sewing this one together will show you if your 1/4 inch seams are accurate...



Sew one 4-1/2 inch piece Right Sides Together and using a 1/4 inch seam to either side of the centre square.

Press to the darker fabric

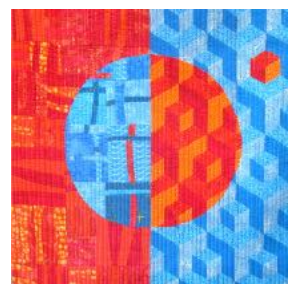


Sew one longer piece to each of the other two sides and press to the long strips..

That's it! Could not be simpler!

Set the blocks with the long strips alternately up-and-down and across-ways so you only have to match seams at the corners

Table runner has 12 blocks, make more for a bigger quilt...
